
Is your child experiencing difficulty with Instrumental Music?

Some things to think about before a conversation with the teachers:

Does my child refuse to practise?	Does my child struggle to wake up for early morning rehearsals?	Does my child find it difficult to be organised?	Does my child have friends in the program?
Does my child have time set aside to practise?	Does my child need some incentives?	Does my child need some extra support or encouragement?	Is my child finding reading music difficult?
Is my child finding making sounds on their instrument difficult?	Is my child feeling performance anxiety?	Is my child experiencing a negative social interaction with another student in the class?	Are there other issues we should know about?

We can work through these issues with you so that your student can continue and be successful in the program, developing their resilience and persistence along the way!
