This funding will be used to


- Increase student performance in English to 20% As, 50% A or B, 85% A,B or C in English
- Improve mean scale score percentile to equal or better than ICSEA percentile
- Increase the number of students achieving the National Minimum Standard to 100% for Reading
- Further improve teacher pedagogy and practice through focused coaching and professional development to improve student performance in reading
- Increase the number of students in the Upper Two Bands in Reading to 50%

Our initiatives include

- Implement a whole school explicit teaching framework, delivered by well trained teachers, teacher aides, and supported by STLaN and EALD teachers.
- Develop and implement intervention/enrichment programs based on identified cohort needs in reading.
- To use standardised evidenced based assessment to assess student's current performance, plan. intervention/enrichment programs; teach to the needs of the students and re-assess students to monitor progress.
- Build staff capability to effectively deliver the Australian Curriculum through the implementation of mentoring and coaching programs.
- Develop a supportive school environment which focuses on clear expectations and wellbeing.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing support staff to provide literacy intervention for identified students \$67,000
- Employing and training teacher aides to support the teaching of reading \$23,434
- Enhance leadership allocation to lead the improvement agenda \$74,500
- Provide professional development to improve teacher's capacity to improve student performance in reading \$64,000
- Purchasing resources and providing professional development to enhance the supportive school environment initiatives \$40,000
- Employ staff to support student engagement \$83,500
